Arson Investigation / Missing Person

At approximately 9:22am today, officers responded to 146 Wayah Creek Drive in response to a possible fire in the apartment. The fire apparently extinguished itself and was in a smoldering state.

Officers arrived on the scene to conduct an initial investigation, which revealed evidence of an arson. There were no occupants inside the apartment at the time. The resident, who is a Ft. Bragg soldier, has not been located. This case is currently being investigated as a missing persons and arson case.

Detectives are currently coordinating with Ft. Bragg officials regarding this case.

UPDATE

July 7, 2008

The missing soldier has been identified as 2nd Lieutenant, Holley Wimunc, 24 years of age, assigned to Charlie Company, Womack Army Hospital at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina.

Attached is a photo of Ms. Wimunc.
