### **SYNOPSIS**

The Defendants have been charged by indictment with the crimes of Conspiracy to Commit a Crime, Conspiracy to Commit Kidnapping, Kidnapping with use of a Deadly Weapon, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Robbery with Use of a Deadly Weapon, Burglary while in Possession of a Deadly Weapon, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and Coercion with use of a Deadly Weapon, alleged to have occurred at the Palace Station Hotel and Casino on September 13, 2007. The defendants have denied all charges and have pleaded Not Guilty.

#### HARDSHIP CONSIDERATION

The Court and the parties estimate that after a jury is selected this case may last approximately three weeks. Mere inconvenience or the usual financial hardships of jury service will not be sufficient to excuse a prospective juror.
