**Motion to Compel Copies of the Screen Shots or Printouts Concerning the
Forensic Examination Done on the Computer of Ricardo Morales**

COMES NOW the Defendant, CASEY MARIE ANTHONY, by and through undersigned counsel, and moves this Honorable Court to enter an order compelling the State of Florida and its various police agencies to produce any and all copies of screen shots and printouts of the forensic examination done on Ricardo Morales' computer. In support thereof the Defendant would allege that:

1. On January 20, 2009 the State turned over approximately 300 pages of new discovery. In that discovery at pages 3063 through 3065, was a report concerning the computer of Ricardo Morales. The State noted that on Mr. Morales' My Space page, he had a picture with a woman that stated "win her over with chloroform™." A copy of that report is attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

2. The report notes that Morales dated Casey Anthony from January 23rd to mid-April. If the Court will recall, previous discovery turned over to the Defense indicated that there were searches on the Anthony family computer on March 17th and March 21st concerning the word "chloroform." Soon after those searches were performed, Casey Anthony broke up with Ricardo Morales, which is the same time that Morales had posted on his Myspace page the picture concerning "winning women over by chloroforming them."

3. The State performed a forensic examination on Morales' computer and they concluded there was "nothing incriminating." However, they did note that files were deleted the day the computer was turned over to the State.

3. While the State is now in the process of providing the hard drive to Morales' computer, they have yet to provide copies of the screen shots or printouts of what they saw on Morales' computer and have not yet provided a copy of the screen shots, printouts, Excel charts or forensic analysis of the deleted files.

4. We are entitled to know what it was that the State felt was not "incriminating" in order to compare it to any computer analysis that we may wish to perform in this regard.
