MOTION TO RESTRICT DISCLOSURE ^{URG}

GEORGE ANTHONY, a witness in the above referenced case, pursuant to Fl. R. Criminal P. 3.220 (d) (3) (e), moves this Court to restrict disclosure of certain documents and as grounds therefore will show:

1. George Anthony is the father of CASEY ANTHONY, the defendant in the above referenced case.
2. Mr. Anthony attempted suicide on January 22, 2009.
3. Mr. Anthony left a note to his wife and children. This note was seized by the Daytona Beach Police Department when Mr. Anthony was located in Daytona Beach in the early morning hours on January 23, 2009.
4. This note was one of the items seized under Baker Act Mr. Anthony as a result of his suicide attempt.
5. Information used to involuntarily or voluntarily commit any individual under Florida's Baker Act are not public record. The note left by Mr. Anthony was provided to the Office of The States Attorney, Ninth Judicial Circuit by the Daytona Beach Police Department. The note has no connection to the criminal case against Casey Anthony.
6. The note contains very personal information intended for nobody other than Mr. Anthonys' family.
7. It is undersigned counsels believe that this is medical information protected by statute. In


