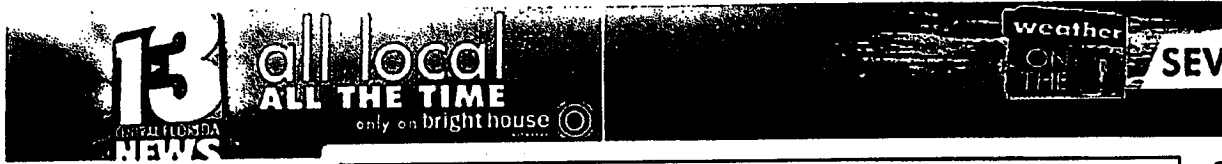

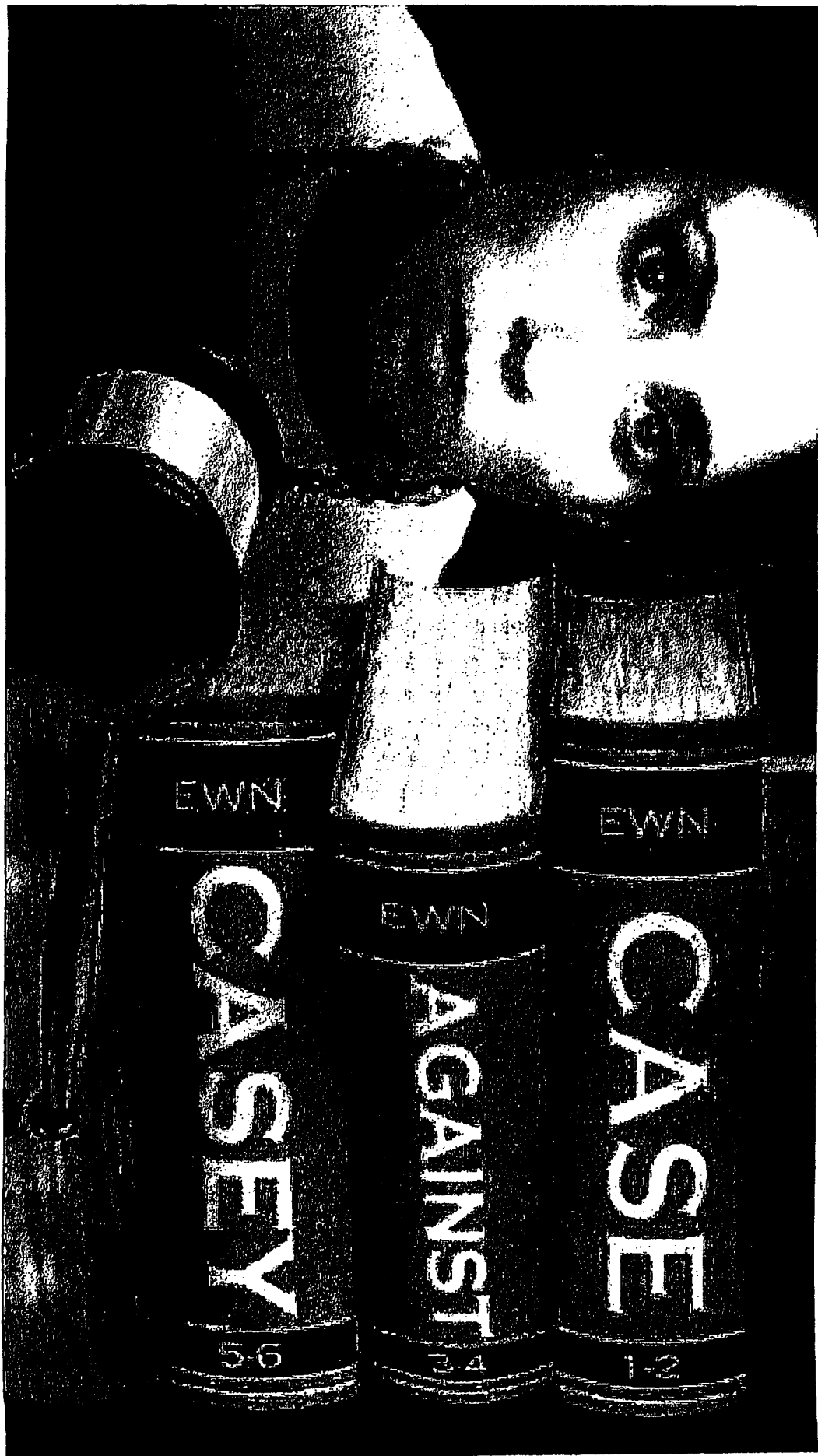

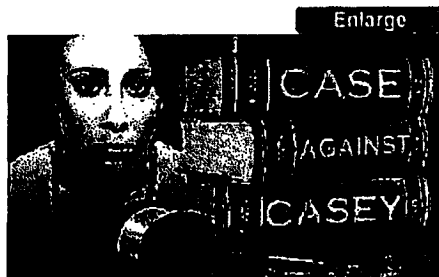

One Year Later: The Case Against Casey

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. -- Eyewitness News has covered the case against Casey Anthony from the beginning. Through its bizarre twists and turns, WFTV has been there every step of the way.

Casey Anthony, 23, is charged with murdering her 2-year-old daughter Caylee Anthony last year.

One month later, George and Cindy Anthony found Casey's abandoned car and said it smelled like death.

"There's something wrong. I found my daughter's car today and it smells like there's been a body in the

damn car," Cindy Anthony said in a call to 911.

The next day, Casey Anthony paraded past Eyewitness News' camera after being caught in a litany of lies about a nanny and a job she didn't have. Her parents pressed her in jail about what happened to Caylee.

"We're going to see her little face again. I pray to God, Casey," Cindy said.

"I know in my heart she's not far. I can feel it," Casey told them.

While Casey seemed to be comforting her parents, prosecutors believe she might have been taunting them because she murdered Caylee and knew where she was.

California bounty hunter Leonard Padilla came to Orlando to try to find out where Caylee was by posting Casey's \$500,000 bond.

There was no hiding for Casey on October 14, 2008. Her father testified against her. Later that day, a grand jury indicted her for first-degree murder.

"I was put in a position where someone was trying to trick a confession out of me and that's not going to happen," Casey was said in the patrol car when she was taken into custody.

On December 11, when a child's remains were found in a wooded area less than one mile from Casey's house, wrapped in bags with duct tape over the mouth, Casey watched Channel 9's special report in jail and guards watched her.

"She was in the waist chains and handcuffs and she kept saying the waist chains kept getting tighter and tighter and will you please loosen them," said jail officer Lt. Tammy Unser.

The chain of evidence has tightened around her. The tape and bags are similar to those in her house and even the heart-shaped sticker that investigators say was stuck over the duct tape.

Casey's controversial defense team has hired someone considered to be one of the best to try to spare Casey from a conviction and a death sentence for Caylee's murder. Andrea Lyon joined the defense, because Casey's current lawyer, Jose Baez, is not qualified to try a death penalty case.

After a year, the case is far from over. Casey Anthony's trial is scheduled for October. Eyewitness News' experts say that's not likely to happen.

Next in the case, there will be a hearing over whether the state should be allowed to release a videotape of Casey's reaction the day she learned a child's remains were found. The hearing date has not been set.

The Anthony family will also be in court soon to fight the release of Caylee's autopsy report.

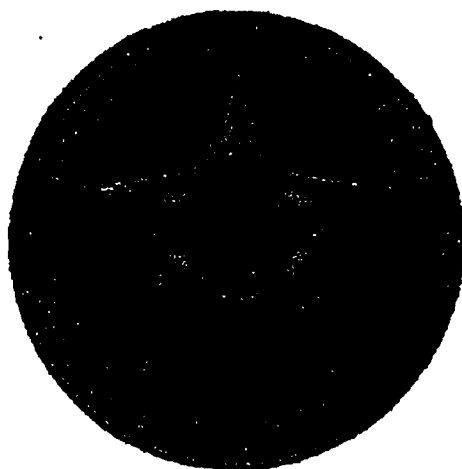

Executive Summary

The Orange County Sheriff's Office Critical Incident Management Team was called to support the search efforts for a missing child Caylee Anthony. Our mission was to support the Specialized Patrol Section [K-9, Ag/Marine, Mounted] and Equusearch in their search of south east Orlando and Orange County.

The Specialized Patrol Section's mission was to support the Equusearch organization's search efforts by vetting or verifying identified objects of interest found by their volunteers and provide search capabilities if Equusearch did not have the capability.

The search operation was organized and run by the Equusearch organization. Equusearch brought in an approximate total of 2,500 volunteers in the week long operation. Each week day had approximately 100 volunteers and the final Saturday had approximately 1200 volunteers.

Equusearch coordinated the volunteers, search teams, search areas, food & water donations, PIO and all other issues related to their organization. The only area the OCSO stepped in was the Saturday with a large number of volunteers expected. In a review of their daily volunteer sign in and coordination it was obvious their system would fail when a significant number of volunteers should up as was expected on Saturday. Mrs. Tammy Grabill quickly foresaw the impending issue and formed a solution. Her organization strategy was adopted and implemented for the Saturday rush and worked flawlessly to handle the 1200 volunteers.

No major issues in agency organization, equipment or usage were identified.

Incident Overview

The Orange County Sheriff's Office Critical Incident Management Team was called to support the search efforts for a missing child Caylee Anthony. Our mission was to support the Specialized Patrol Section [K-9, Ag/Marine, Mounted] in their search of south east Orlando and Orange County. The Specialized Patrol Section's mission was to support the Equusearch organization's search efforts by vetting or verifying identified objects of interest found by their volunteers and provide search capabilities if Equusearch did not have the capability.

Equusearch is a non-profit missing person search organization based in Texas. The organization was invited to Orlando by the Anthony family. [REDACTED] between the family and the organization deteriorated and the Orange County Sheriff's Office stepped in to support the organization with their broad base area search. Equusearch arrived in Orlando with approximately fourteen personnel. Their organization activated or brought in a mobile office, a motor coach, search

More Than 1,000 Volunteers Search For Caylee Anthony

Search Will Resume Sunday Morning

POSTED: 6:25 pm EST November 8, 2008
UPDATED: 6:36 pm EST November 8, 2008

ORLANDO, Fla. -- Volunteers turned out in large numbers to search for missing 3-year-old Caylee Anthony on Saturday.

People came from miles around to help search a 25-mile radius near the Orlando International Airport in east Orange County for the remains of Caylee and missing Orlando woman Jennifer Kesse.

It's one of the mostly highly publicized searches in recent history in Orange County.

About 1,300 volunteers combed the area in East Orange County.

The searchers wrapped up at 5 p.m. Saturday, but will resume on Sunday morning.

The volunteers spent the day combing swampy and wooded areas around Blanchard Park and Moss Park. They found plenty of animal bones, but so far, no evidence connected to Caylee.

The volunteer turnout did not break the record for the largest nation search. That would have required 3,000 people.

The searchers headed into dense brush near the Orlando International Airport -- an area where investigators traced cell phone pings from Casey Anthony's phone.

The group did find bones, but said they were clearly not human.

"There's a pile of bones there but it appears to be an animal," a volunteer said.

Bones were also found inside a plastic bag in Blanchard Park and were suspicious enough to be checked by some students studying to be crime scene technicians.

Equusearch said they quickly determined the bones belonged to a pet dog.

"Any days that we're searching we find bones," said Mandy Albritton of Equusearch. "Animals go into the woods to die. You're going to find animal bones in the woods."

As for George and Cindy Anthony, Caylee's grandparents, there was no sign of them at the search on Saturday.

It appears Equusearch and the Anthonys have come to a sort of truce, agreeing to disagree over whether Caylee is alive.

"I know the Anthonys are firm in the fact, until we have confirmed remains, they won't either, and we can accept that," Albritton said.

The attorney who represents George and Cindy Anthony, Mark Nejame, was at the search early Saturday morning showing his support.

Also helping search was bounty hunter Leonard Padilla and several dozens of his colleagues.

The search will pick up again at 8 a.m. Sunday.

Volunteers Come From All Over To Search

Most of the searchers had never met Caylee Anthony, but they came from miles away to be a part of the effort on Saturday.

Volunteer Pat Roberts said he'd never seen a search effort of this magnitude before.

The goal everyone shared this weekend is to bring home Caylee.

"It's consumed my life for the last few months," Diane McDonald said. "I watch it every night on TV."

"It's a discussion every day at work, and we are just consumed with it," another volunteer said.
"That poor little girl."

Texas Equusearch brought in a mobile command center and converted a field into their main base camp for Caylee

"I'm really impressed so far," said Albritton.

Hundreds were already at the site early Saturday, but hundreds of other cars were seen lining up, still arriving for a search that will last through the weekend.

A college professor brought along his class of young aspiring crime scene investigators.

"It's one thing to be theoretical in classroom, it's another to be able to participate in a crime scene experience for the student," said Paul Friedman of Palm Beach Community College.

Once everyone signed their release form, they started to canvass a 25-square-mile area.

Bounty hunter Leonard Padilla said the story that has captured thousands will come to an end.

"They will find Caylee," he said. "I have every guarantee of that."

Even though Caylee is still missing, her mother Casey Anthony sits in Orange County Jail charged with the child's murder.

Investigators said they have enough circumstantial evidence, including DNA from Casey Anthony's car, that indicates the toddler is dead.

Casey Anthony is being held without bond.

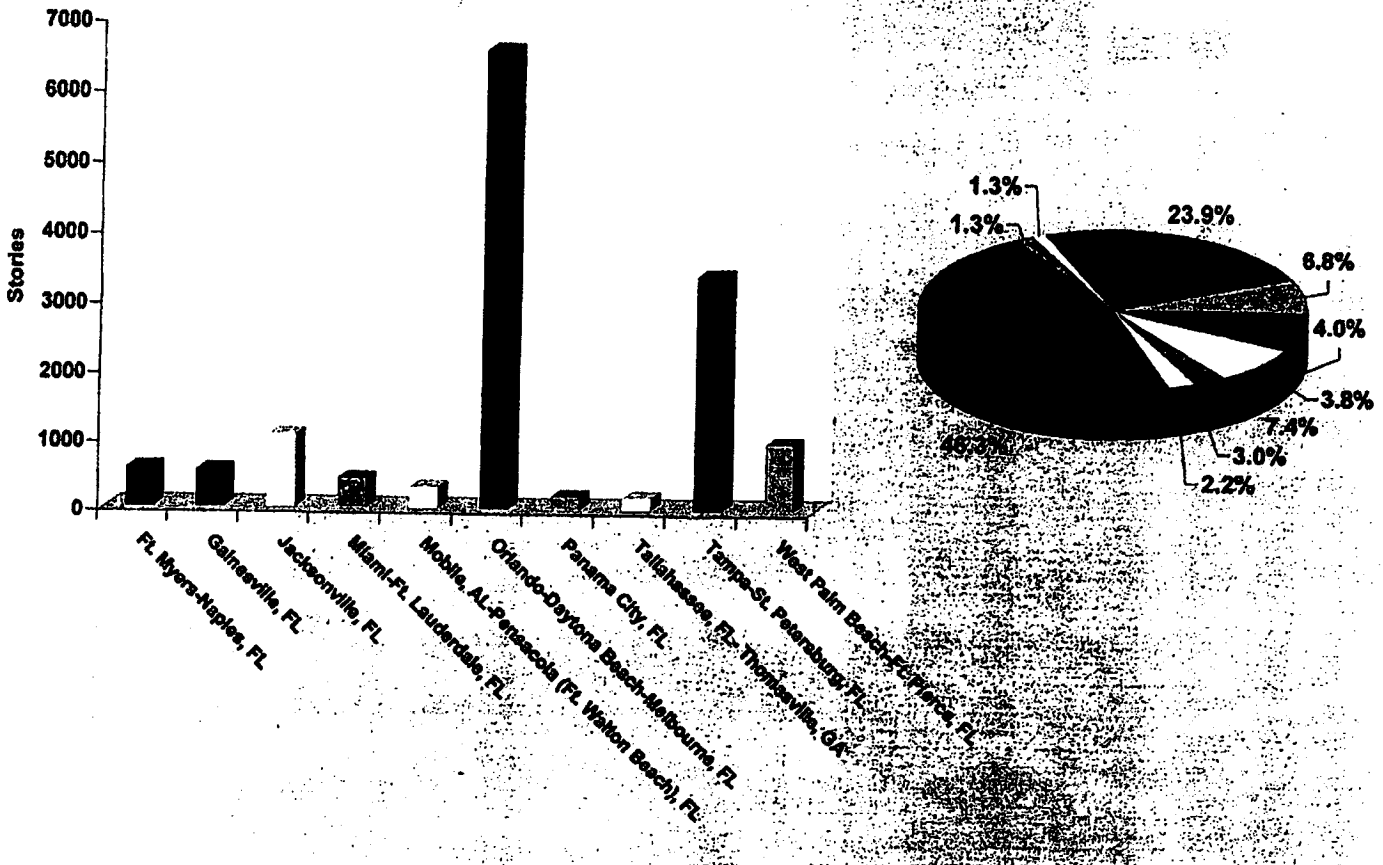

I, Casey Anthony, do hereby state that the following facts are true and correct.

1. The media has extensively covered my case from the moment of my initial arrest on July 16, 2008.
2. Media coverage in print and television has been negative and inflammatory. Upon my first release from jail in August reporters harassed me and members of my family continually asking me if I had killed my daughter and why I did not care about her.
3. Protestors have staged protests outside of my family's home while I was staying there in September. The protestors were violent and insulting to me and my family to the point that I was concerned for my own safety and that of my family members.

4. I am afraid that there is no way for me to receive a fair trial in Orange County or any of the surrounding area due to these facts and fully support my attorney in his efforts to relocate this proceeding to Miami-Dade County.
