Subject	Missing Person Phuong Le		

As of 5/3/10 the whereabouts of Phuong Le are still unknown. Fairfield and Suisun Police Detectives served search warrants at two locations to gather information surrounding her disappearance. These search warrants were conducted at her former employers residence and place of business. He is not a suspect in her disappearance but has corresponded with her as recent as April 25th, prior to her disappearance. Detectives are currently reviewing evidence collected during those search warrants.

On 5/01/10 Family members and friends of the Phuong Le received instant messages and text messages regarding her whereabouts. The message content was suspicious in nature and therefore detectives began tracking the source of the messages. It was determined that a 22 yr old resident of Chester Township, Pennsylvania had sent harassing messages and with the cooperation of local law enforcement the suspect was identified and the messages deemed to be a hoax. The suspect was arrested by Pennsylvania authorities. It is rumors, hoaxes, and suppositions such as this, that distract officers from our investigation efforts to locate Phuong Le.

Fairfield Police and Suisun Police met with the Le family this morning to brief them on the status of the case and information that detectives have uncovered to this point, The family is very cooperative and we continue to work together to locate Phuong Le.
