

## TRANSPORTATION

### BICYCLES

Bike racks will be available at the PGA Public Parking Lot, the Ocean Course entrance and all On-Island Shuttle stops, for those wishing to ride their bike to the Championship. All bicycle parking will be complimentary.

### TAXIS, LIMOUSINES AND AUTHORIZED CHARTER VEHICLES

There will be a specific section of the PGA Public Parking Lot for taxis, limo and private vehicles to drop off and pick up guests.

Bus parking will also be available in the PGA Public Parking Lot for groups arriving in vehicles larger than personal use automobiles (15 passenger vans, motor coaches, etc). These larger vehicles must access the PGA Public Parking Lot from the gate located on the Kiawah Island Parkway.

All vehicles will be subject to the same parking fee each time they enter the PGA Public Lot. Parking passes for all vehicles may be obtained in the same way as the general public, either in advance or at the gate.

### RIDESHARE & CARPOOLING

The PGA of America also encourages individuals to take advantage of the Trident Rideshare Program. Rideshare provides a cost effective and environmentally friendly way for all lowcountry residents to travel to Kiawah Island and better enjoy this year's Championship. ### MOBILITY IMPAIRED PARKING

Designated parking for wheelchair bound spectators will be provided. Please call The Convention Store at (877) 472-7275 for more information. Wheelchairs will not be available for rent, but spectators may bring wheelchairs with them to the Championship.

Wheelchair accessible viewing areas will be located at the Practice Range tee, Hole #1 Tee and right of the 18th Green.

### KIAWAH ON-ISLAND SHUTTLE

A complimentary On-Island Shuttle System will be provided for those staying on Kiawah Island.

The On-island shuttle will have 23 stops located throughout the island on three separate routes, operating on 20 minute intervals. Each stop will have bicycle parking available.

On-island shuttle service will begin each day at 5:00 AM with the last shuttle departing the Ocean Course at 9:00 PM.

## PGA PUBLIC PARKING

The PGA Public Parking Lot for Spectators and Volunteers will be behind the Freshfields Village Shopping Center, located between Kiawah and Seabrook Islands. There will be no public parking on Kiawah Island during the PGA Championship.

Daily parking passes for spectators may be purchased in advance for \$10 per vehicle, per day up until July 15th by visiting [pga2012.com](http://pga2012.com) or by calling the PGA Ticketing Center at 1-800-PGA-GOLF (1-800-742-4653). During Championship Week, parking will be \$20 per vehicle, per day at the gate.

There will be no overnight parking in the PGA Public Parking Lot, and any vehicles left overnight will be towed at the owner's expense.

### DIRECTIONS TO PGA PUBLIC PARKING

Traffic traveling northbound or eastbound from outside the Charleston area  
(Savannah, Hilton Head Island, Columbia, I-95)

- From U.S. Hwy. 17 turn onto Main Rd. (6.6 mi)
- Main Rd. becomes Bohicket Rd. (7.3 mi)
- Bohicket Rd. becomes Betsy Kerrison Pkwy. (3.1 mi)
- Follow signage into PGA Public Parking

Traffic traveling from all areas north of Kiawah  
(James Island, Charleston, Mount Pleasant)

- Merge onto Lockwood Dr. via ramp to U.S. Hwy. 17 (0.5 mi)
- Left onto U.S. 17 Bus. S (1.1 mi)
- Left onto Wesley Dr. (0.2 mi)
- Right onto Maybank Hwy. (5.2 mi)
- Left onto River Rd. (12.0 mi)
- Left onto Betsy Kerrison Pkwy. (3.1 mi)
- Follow signage into PGA Public Parking

## GENERAL SPECTATOR INFORMATION

### PHOTOS / AUTOGRAPHS

Cameras are only allowed at The Ocean Course during Practice Rounds, Monday through Wednesday, and are not permitted on-site during Championship Rounds, Thursday through Sunday. Mobile device cameras may **not** be used to take photos during Championship Rounds. Autographs may be requested and given at the contestants' convenience at the Practice Range and Putting Green during Practice Rounds only.

### RE-ADMISSION POLICY

There will be no daily re-admission to the grounds of the PGA Championship. If you leave the grounds, you must have a full ticket to return to the Championship. Once the bottom of the ticket has been scanned, it will no longer provide admission. The only exception is when the Weather Warning signs are posted, which may require an evacuation of the golf course. Please wear your ticket in plain view at all times as security personnel will not allow admission to the PGA Championship for individuals without appropriate credentials.

### JUNIORS GET IN FREE!

To provide the ultimate family entertainment value, The PGA of America is excited to offer up to four (4) complimentary junior ground admissions with every paid adult ticket. Junior admissions apply to youth age 17 or younger, and may be obtained at the Main Spectator Entrance Admissions Office on the day of entry. Wanamaker ticket upgrades for juniors may be purchased for \$25 per day at Admissions. Please note that junior tickets do not gain access into private hospitality areas.

### ACTIVE MILITARY ADMISSION POLICY

To honor the men and women who serve our country in the armed forces, active military personnel receive complimentary Daily Grounds access to the 2012 PGA Championship. A valid active military ID is required on the day of attendance to receive the free ticket, which can be obtained at the Admission Sales and Will Call Office. One additional spouse ticket will also be complimentary with the presence of an active military ID, even in the event of a Championship sellout.

### WEATHER

Average August temperatures on Kiawah Island range from a high of 88 degrees to a low of 76 degrees.

### INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR SPECTATORS

Please observe the Leader Boards and Thru Boards for the Weather Warning Sign which will appear when inclement weather is approaching the site. When the signs appear, spectators are advised to take precautions and seek shelter PRIOR to play being suspended. If the sirens sound, seek shelter immediately.



### DANGER FROM WILDLIFE

Please do not disturb or feed alligators, snakes or other natural wildlife while on the grounds of the Ocean Course. Use caution when walking in areas near ponds and tall grasses.

### MOBILE DEVICE POLICY

Those wishing to use their mobile devices will be asked to adjust the volume setting to "silent" or "vibrate" while at the Championship.

- Guests may accept or make phone calls in designated areas throughout the golf course, primarily near concession stands and away from play.
- Digital messaging and checking data is allowed on the golf course.
- Mobile device camera use is NOT permitted during the Championship Rounds.
- No video recording will be permitted at any time during Championship Week.

Spectators attempting to use their mobile device in unauthorized areas or in ways not sanctioned will be asked to surrender the device and pick it up at a designated location after they depart the golf course.

### CONDUCT, CUSTOMS AND ETIQUETTE

Please be advised of the following standards of conduct and etiquette:

- Everyone is requested to display traditional customs of etiquette, decorum and behavior, and to obey all Championship policies, signs and verbal instructions of Championship Officials.
- For the safety of everyone and in keeping with policy established at major sporting events, running is considered to be unacceptable behavior.
- Although cheering and positive gallery responses to great play are encouraged, unsolicited and consistent calls from the gallery are prohibited.
- Please stay behind the gallery ropes and cooperate with the Marshals.
- Please kneel or sit if you are in the front row and remain still throughout each shot.

### ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

The items listed below are strictly prohibited on the grounds of The Ocean Course. All bags will be searched upon entering the Championship.

- Personal electronics such as hand-held games, radios, televisions, iPods, iPads, etc.
- All oversized chairs with wide arm rests (small, portable/folding chairs are permitted)
- Weapons of any kind (regardless of permit)
- Signs, posters and placards
- Coolers, ladders, milk crates, dogs and other pets
- Alcoholic Beverages

Please leave all prohibited items in your vehicle as they will not be permitted at the Championship.
