**RECAP:** The South Bay Lakers dropped their third consecutive road game as they lost to the Rio Grande Valley Vipers, 124-118, on Thursday night. Thomas Bryant poured in 31 points and Scott Machado tallied 18 points with a career-high 14 assists, but South Bay (14-9) fell behind by as many as 21 points and could not regain the lead. Monte Morris had a huge game for Rio Grande Valley (16-9) as he scored 20 points and dished out 17 assists in the win. A high scoring first quarter found the Vipers ahead, 40-36, behind 11 early points from Morris, while Bryant paced the Lakers with 10 points through one. The Vipers pulled away in the second as they closed the quarter on a 28-4 run to take a 76-55 halftime lead. Stephau Branch tried to keep his team close with 10 points in the quarter, but the balance of the Vipers helped them extend their lead. South Bay struggled to cut the deficit in the third, as Rio Grande Valley led 99-82 going into the fourth. Bryant tallied 12 more in the third as neither team hit a shot from deep in the period. The Lakers showed fight in the fourth quarter as they cut the deficit to three, thanks to 11 points from Vander Blue, but were not able to leave with a victory.

**RECAP:** The South Bay Lakers couldn't get their offense going as they fell to the Iowa Wolves, 123-89, on Wednesday night. Travis Wear scored 18 points to lead South Bay (16-11), but only two other Lakers reached double figures in the loss. Iowa (14-11) on the other hand saw eight players score in double figures, led by Amile Jefferson's huge double-double with 22 points and 15 rebounds. The Wolves got off to a quick start behind 17 combined points from Anthony Brown and Elijah Millsap as they took a 36-25 lead through one. Thomas Bryant paced the Lakers with seven points and four rebounds in the first period. Iowa maintained a strong lead, 67-53 at the half, as Millsap scored eight more in the second. Wear handled the scoring for South Bay in the second with eight points. Melo Trimble got going in the third for Iowa with eight points to extend the Wolves lead, 96-72, through three. Stephoun Branch did his best to keep South Bay in the game with nine points in the third. South Bay continued to struggle, scoring only 17 points in the fourth, as they dropped their first home game of 2018. Wear's 18 points led the way for South Bay as Demarcus Holland (10 points) was the only other starter to reach double figures. V.J. Beachem (14 points) paced the second unit and Branch nearly grabbed a double-double (nine points, nine rebounds). Scott Machado posted nine points to go along with 10 assists, but South Bay was outscored by 20 points in the paint (58-38) as they fell to the Wolves.

## LAKERS LATEST

### LAKERS<sup>2</sup>

Alex Caruso and Gary Payton II will be suiting up for the Lakers in the South Bay and in Los Angeles. The two guards were signed to two-way contracts and will be able to spend between the NBA and the G League. Caruso can spend up to 45 days with LAL, while Payton II, who was signed on 1/15, can spend up to 23 days with Los Angeles

- Caruso rejoined LAL on 1/14. Has appeared in 13 games for LAL, totaling 23 points (10-24 FG) and 13 assists. Caruso made his Los Angeles debut on opening night, tallying two points and a pair of assists in 12 minutes
- Payton II has appeared in two games for LAL, averaging 3.0 points and 2.0 assists. Payton II made his Los Angeles debut on 1/15 at Memphis, playing the entire fourth quarter and posting four points and four assists.

### MAKING THEIR CASE

South Bay went undefeated at the 2018 Showcase as they beat the Lakeland Magic, 94-86, behind 22 points and eight assists from Alex Caruso and a double-double from Travis Wear. The Lakers opened the 2018 Showcase with a 20-point win over the Long Island Nets. Seven Lakers scored in double-figures as the Lakers never lost their lead. With the sweep, South Bay improved to 11-10 all time at the annual showcase.

### TOP 10 FOR NUMBER 10

Nine-year veteran of the G League and South Bay Lakers mainstay, Andre Ingram moved into the G League's top ten all time scoring on 12/30 with four points in front of his home crowd.

### GREAT SCOTT!

Scott Machado ranks second (8.2) in the league in assists per game. Machado picked up his ninth double-double of the year on 1/4 at Rio Grande Valley with 18 points and a career-high 14 assists. Machado kept the Lakers undefeated on the road in a 148-144 overtime win on 12/5 as he posted a career-high 39 points to go along with 10 assists.

### DEMARCUS BALLIN'

Demarcus Holland came off the bench and had the best performance of his career on 12/30 as he tallied 17 points and 10 rebounds, both career highs. Holland also finished the game with a team-high +/- of 20.

### CARUSHOW

Alex Caruso has been posting career numbers left and right this season. He tied his career-high of seven steals on 12/19 at Delaware. On 12/17 vs. Memphis, Caruso dished out a career-high 13 assists in South Bay's 137-132 win. He also had a career-night on 12/8 vs. Sioux Falls as he posted career-highs in points (41) and assists (12) to go along with eight rebounds and three steals as South Bay came back from a 15-point deficit to grab the 139-135 overtime win.

### LEADERBOARD

The Lakers rank third in the G League in three-point percentage (.382) having made 328 of 858 shots from distance. The Lakers also rank third in the league in field goal percentage (.485) and third in assists per game (24.9).

### HONOR ROLL

South Bay Lakers head coach Coby Karl was named the G League Coach of the Month for the Month of November. Under Karl, the Lakers shot 52.0% from the field and 46.4% from three, both marks that led the league. South Bay averaged the second-most points, 121.0, and the third-most assists, 24.0, while also posting the highest offensive rating (113.7) in the league. The award is the first of Karl's career and the first such award in franchise history.



### RED, WEAR AND BLUE

Travis Wear was chosen to represent Team USA as part of the 12-man roster for the November first-round FIBA Basketball World Cup 2019 Americas Qualifiers. Wear will begin training with the team on November 17 in Greensboro, NC and will play in games against Puerto Rico and Mexico. In his last tune-up before donning the red, white and blue, Wear hit 4-4 from deep as part of his 17-point performance in a 119-99 win over the Iowa Wolves on 11/15.

- In his first game with Team USA, Wear contributed seven points, four rebounds and two assists in a 85-78 win over Puerto Rico.
- In his second game, Wear tallied a double-double with 14 points and ten rebounds, to help the US grab a 91-55 victory over Mexico.

**SHOW ME WHAT ZU GOT**

Ivica Zubac continued his strong play in his second year with South Bay as he scored a career-high 28 points on 12/22 at Canton. He scored 26 points in back-to-back games, 12/19 at Delaware and 12/17 vs. Memphis. Zubac has appeared in eight games with South Bay this season, averaging 21.4 points, 9.1 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game.

**LAL-SBL**

Two Los Angeles Lakers assignees made their season debuts for South Bay against the Iowa Wolves on 11/15. Ivica Zubac, who played 14 games with the team last year, scored a career-high 23 points to go along with nine rebounds, three assists and three steals, while Josh Hart scored 18 points in his first G League game. The pair of assignees followed up their strong debuts on 11/18 at Austin as Hart tallied 17 points, six rebounds and three assists, while Zubac posted a double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds.

**3.J. BEACHEM**

V.J. Beachem tied a franchise record on 11/24 at Texas when he hit eight three pointers in South Bay's 125-112 win as he scored a career-high 30 points. Beachem (8-10) became the first Laker to hit eight threes in a game since Gerald Green did so on 2/6/12 vs. Erie. Beachem joins Green and Brian Chase (4/3/07 vs. Albuquerque) as the only Lakers to accomplish this feat.

**EVEN PERCENTAGES ARE BIGGER IN TEXAS**

South Bay's 63.9% shooting performance in their win at Texas, was their highest of the season and only .004 away from their franchise record. Their performance is the best shooting performance in the G League this season.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN**

Alex Caruso etched his name in the South Bay record books on Saturday, 11/18 as he nabbed a career-high seven steals in Austin. His seven steals tie him for most in a game by any player in South Bay history. Caruso achieved the feat again on 12/19 at Delaware. The feat was last achieved by Josh Magette on 12/22/15 at Santa Cruz.

**LAKERS SEE DUB IN HOME OPENER**

In the first regular season game at the UCLA Health Training Center, the Lakers erased a 20-point Santa Cruz lead, to win 127-123. South Bay was led by Thomas Bryant (30 points, 8 rebounds), Alex Caruso (career-high 29 points, 7 assists) and Scott Machado (19 points, 8 assists).

**BACK-TO-BACKS**

The Lakers will play eight sets of back-to-back games this year, one less than they had during the 2016-17 season.

**SCHEDULE QUIRKS**

- The longest road trip of the season was 10 days/four games between December 19-28. SBL went 1-3 on the trip.
- The longest home stand of the season is 15 days/six games between February 24-March 10.
- South Bay plays 16 of their 24 home games on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.

**SEASON RECAP**

South Bay finished the 2016-17 season as the Pacific Division Champions (34-16) with the second-best record in team history. The team tied the record for best start in league history when they got out to a 24-6 start to the year.

**VEGAS VICTORY**

Three members of the South Bay Lakers helped contribute to the Lakers first Summer League Championship in July. Thomas Bryant (5.1 pts, 3.3 rbs), Alex Caruso (7.4 pts, 3.3 rbs, 3.9 ast) and Travis Wear (7.9 pts, 3.9 rbs, 1.0 ast) will look to bring their productive play into the 2017-18 G League season.

**FRANCHISE HISTORY**

The South Bay Lakers franchise, in its 11th season, has won three division titles (2012, 2014, 2017) and advanced to the NBA G League Finals twice (2012, 2016). The first team in league history to be owned by an NBA franchise, South Bay is chasing their first G League title.
