



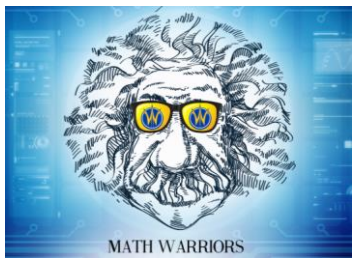

PLAYER TRANSACTIONS



Carl Ona-Embo: The Santa Cruz Warriors acquired guard Carl Ona-Embo out of the NBA D-League available player pool. Ona-Embo (6-1, 175, France) was selected 49th overall in the 2016 NBA D-League Draft by the Salt Lake City Stars and was later waived on November 8. Ona-Embo last played for JL Bourg-en-Bresse in the French LNB Pro B League for the 2015-16 season. He appeared in 36 games (8 starts) and averaged 6.9 points along with 2.8 assists in 22.9 minutes per game.

Damian Jones: The Golden State Warriors re-assigned Damian Jones to Santa Cruz on November 30th after recalling him on November 28th. With the Sea Dubs this season, Jones has averaged 3.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.5 assists in 18.5 minutes over two games (both starts).

RECENT GAMES RECAP

Nov. 25 – The Sea Dubs fell to the Sioux Falls Skyforce 100-93 despite a late rally by the Warriors. Cam Jones led the way for Santa Cruz with 22 points, 7 assists, and 6 rebounds. Phil Pressey recorded a double-double, finishing with 17 points and 11 assists.

Nov. 27 – The Warriors were defeated by the Reno Bighorns 100-84 in the second road game this season. Elgin Cook came off the bench to lead the Dubs with 27 points, while Cam Jones added 16 points, 5 rebounds, and 5 assists.

Nov. 30 – Santa Cruz dropped a wire-to-wire thriller against the Westchester Knicks 99-98 in a matinee thriller. The Warriors received an explosive performance from Elgin Cook, who came off the bench to notch 33 points, 7 rebounds, and 4 assists.

Dec. 1 – The Warriors were defeated by the Long Island Nets 114-104 last Thursday. Santa Cruz's Elgin Cook and Phil Pressey both recorded a game-high-tying 22 points. Cook also posted a double-double for the Warriors with 11 rebounds.

Dec. 3 – The Sea Dubs fell to the Maine Red Claws 115-106 on Saturday. Scott Wood notched 26 points on 5-of-8 shooting from behind the arc. Phil Pressey contributed 20 points, 4 rebounds, and 3 assists, while Dennis Clifford and Cam Jones added 14 points each.
