SCOTT SPENCE

Q. How do you feel after finishing at 4 over, considering how high everybody else was today?

SCOTT SPENCE: I haven't really looked at the scores yet. I watched it a little bit out there. But I just kept playing, plugging along, staying patient. Mike San Filippo, said thank God it's a par 70, he wouldn't have broken 80, if it wasn't.

But the wind swirling, the golf course is tough without any extra conditions and I feel pretty lucky to be where I'm sitting right now.

Q. Talk about any holes that were memorable out there?

SCOTT SPENCE: 3, I ballooned a shot, short of the right bunker, the par-3. And I shanked it in the bunker I had a great lie and the club just moved, and I hit it and then after that I 2-putted for five or for double and then on 6 or 7, the par-4, I made a bad play there. That was the only bad swing of the day, really. I dumped it in the water off the tee and made double. I 3-putted after I knocked it on. It was a good shot to get on the green, but, you know, I only had two bogeys all day and two doubles and two birdies. So I can't complain.

Q. What are you looking to do tomorrow?

SCOTT SPENCE: Stay with my game plan. Try to hit as many fairways as possible. My driver's going real well. And I'm pleased with that. The putting is good. We'll just keep patient and see what happens. It's taken a lot of support for me to get here. I have my boss, Steve Napoli here and I'm in heaven, so I can't complain.

SCOTT MAHLBERG

Q. Just tell me a little bit about your round and what you think of the golf course.

SCOTT MAHLBERG: Well, the course is fantastic. It's very demanding off the tee and around the greens.

Unfortunately, I didn't play as well as I would have liked to. I had 41-41, and let a few shots get away from me. I didn't hit the ball as straight as I wanted to and I had a couple 3-putt and that adds up very quickly when you do that.

Q. How unforgiving is the rough off the fairways?

SCOTT MAHLBERG: Really, you can only expect to advance the ball, if it's sitting down, about 80 yards. To swing as hard as you can.

And there are quite a few holes where there's water crossing the fairway, so if you do hit it in the rough you really need to lay it up short of that water. You can't slash it and get it up by the green and get up-and-down. Because it's not an option.

Q. Was it tougher teeing off later or as opposed to early this morning do you think?

SCOTT MAHLBERG: Well I came out here actually early to warm-up and hit balls and it really wasn't very windy, but it got quite windy. I would say it was about a three club wind by, especially -- I teed off on 1.

By the time we rolled around to 15, the par-3, it was a three club wind at that hole.

Q. How about the greens? I know they're pretty fast and pretty treacherous.

SCOTT MAHLBERG: They were very fast, although they weren't nearly as fast as the putting green and that actually threw me off a little bit. I was short quite a bit until I figured out it really was a lot slower than the putting green. So hopefully I can catch on a little quicker tomorrow.

Q. What do you have to be to win the tournament?

SCOTT MAHLBERG: I was thinking before the tournament it would be 3 or 4-under. We'll see. What's the lowest number now? I think it's 2-under now, right. For the day. 1-under for the day. Well, I think that 3-under or 4-under is going to win. And it may even be even par.

Because if you just get going a little bit bad, you can make bogeys in a hurry.

MICHAEL PARRISH

Q. Tell me a little bit about the round that you had today. I know I was talking to your caddie, he said it was kind of tough out there.

MICHAEL PARRISH: It was very difficult. But I made a couple poor decisions and made a triple and three doubles and just from stupid plays. But putting was tough and just conditions were difficult.

Q. How much do you attribute to the conditions and how much just

to the golf course itself?

MICHAEL PARRISH: It's probably I would say more -- well, it's hard to say. Some of the places I hit it in I don't think it was the conditions that made that much difference. I think it was probably the golf course. It was just very difficult.

Q. Have you played here before?

MICHAEL PARRISH: No, I have not.

Q. What kind of a score would you expect to be among the leaders today?

MICHAEL PARRISH: Oh, talking about after today's round?

Q. Yeah. Or overall. What do you think overall score would win this tournament?

MICHAEL PARRISH: I would think even par is going to be pretty good if the conditions stay like this. But it was really difficult out there today. So it's really hard to say. I would say even par would have a pretty good chance at it. But I think the weather's supposed to get a little nicer, so I think that the golf course is very fair and if you hit the ball good and play well, I think that the birdies are out there. It's just a matter of hitting the ball well.

You got to -- it's a ball-striker golf course, you got to drive it good and you got to putt it good. Off and on do those two things you should play pretty good.
