PARKING INFORMATION & SPECTATOR MAP

ARRIVING VIA CAR

Public Car Parking: Spectators planning on driving to the Grand Slam are encouraged to carpool and are instructed to park in one of two lots:

- Shelly Bay Park
- Smith's Parish Field

All parking will be free of charge and complimentary shuttles will run continuously to and from Mid Ocean Club all three days of the Grand Slam. Parking in each of these lots is first-come, first-served. See schedule of events for information about public shuttle operating hours.

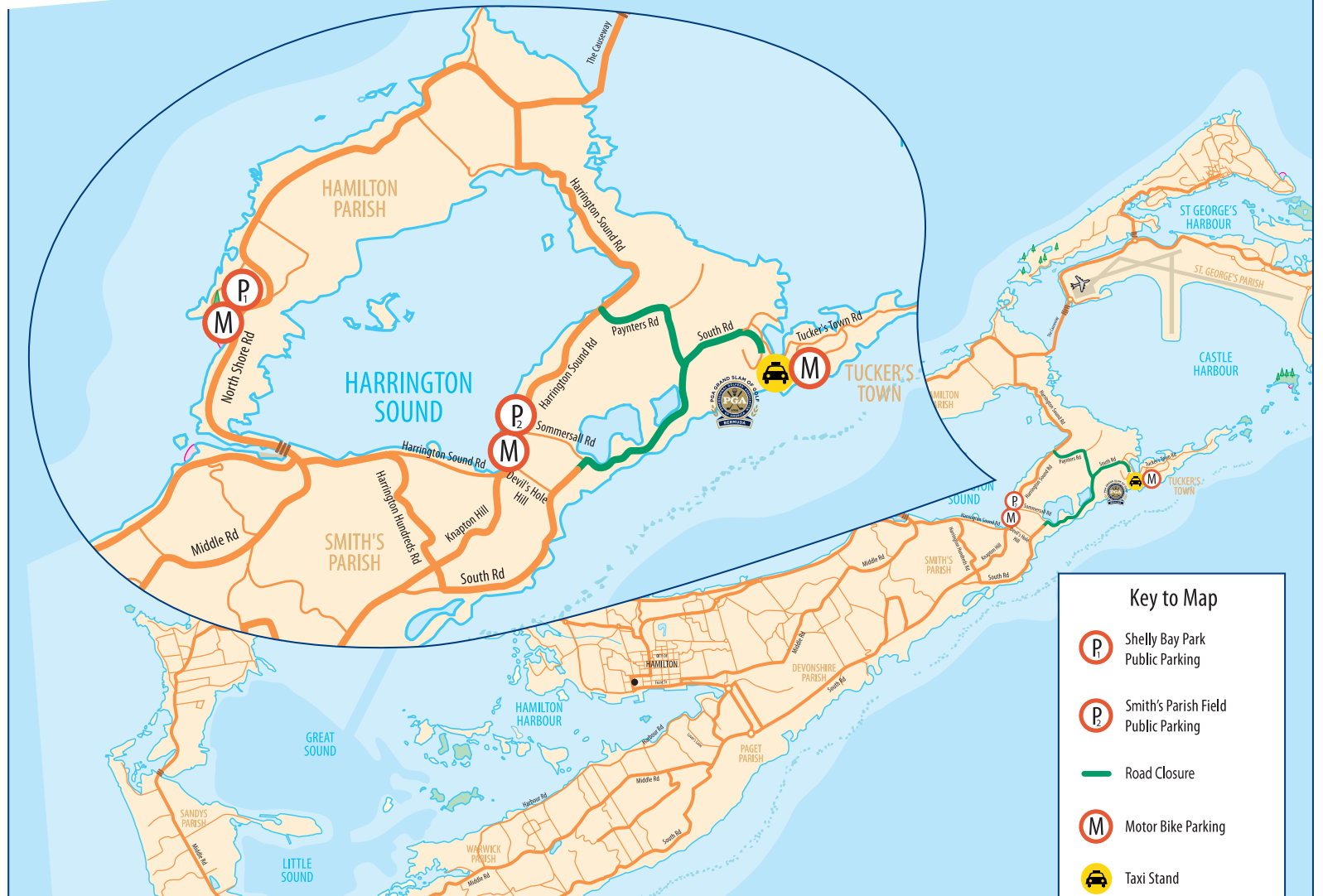
Road Closure Notice:

South Road (starting at Devil's Hole Hill) and Paynters Road will be closed from 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Monday-Wednesday. The Bermuda Police Service will be restricting travel on these roads for properly credentialed vehicles only.

ARRIVING VIA MOTOR BIKE

Public Bike Parking: Spectators planning on taking a motor bike to the Grand Slam have three options for parking:

1. Mid Ocean Club practice range - access for motor bikes on Paynter's Road or South Road will only be granted for those with a ticket to the respective day of the Grand Slam.
2. Shelly Bay Park
3. Smith's Parish Field

ARRIVING VIA PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Public Bus System: Spectators planning on taking a pink government bus from any other location other than the public parking lots are encouraged to take Route 1 that runs from Hamilton and Grotto Bay. This bus will drop off and pick up at the main entrance to the Grand Slam.

ARRIVING VIA TAXI

Taxi Drop-off & Pick-up: If you are planning on taking a taxi to the Grand Slam, all taxis will be directed to drop-off and pick-up at Mid Ocean Club Baby Beach.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

The range will be located on the 18th hole near the forward tees. Contestants will use the 17th green for chipping and putting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Autographs may be requested and given at the players' convenience at the Practice Range and Putting Green during the Pro-Am, Monday, October 13. For the players' consideration, a NO AUTOGRAPH POLICY will be enforced on the grounds of Mid Ocean Club during the Championship Rounds, Tuesday, October 14 through Wednesday, October 15, 2008.

CAMERA POLICY

Cameras are ONLY allowed on-site for the Pro-Am, Monday, October 13, 2008. They are not permitted at Mid Ocean Club during Championship play, Tuesday, October 14 through Wednesday, October 15, 2008.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones, pagers, and other electronic devices (see prohibited items) will not be permitted on the grounds at Mid Ocean Club regardless of profession or current needs. PGA will provide complimentary phones on the premises should the need arise for spectators to make a phone call. Please leave cell phones in your vehicle or you can check your phone at the Spectator Services location at the Main Entrance gate each day.

JUNIOR ADMISSION POLICY

In an effort to encourage youth attendance, Junior Tickets will be offered to children ages 17 and younger at a discounted rate. Cash must be used at on course concession and beverage stands. Travelers checks, credit cards, debit cards and cash are accepted in the Championship Golf Shop and the Main Entrance concession stand.

There will be NO Will Call service for the public at the PGA Grand Slam of Golf. Please do not plan to leave tickets for pick-up at Mid Ocean Club. It is your responsibility to distribute or obtain your tickets prior to arriving on-site.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The items listed are strictly prohibited on the grounds of Mid Ocean Club at all times. Bags will be searched upon entering the event. Anyone violating these policies will be subject to removal from the grounds and the loss of ticket(s).

- All bags, purses, and backpacks that exceed 12 inches in any dimension (length, height, width, etc.).
- All personal electronics to include radios, televisions (including hand-held), cellular telephones, pagers, Palm Pilots, BlackBerry devices, hand held games, Walkmans, iPods, etc.
- Bikes, coolers, ladders, milk crates, plastic buckets, signs, banners, lawn chairs (small, folding, canvas chairs are permitted) and metal spiked golf shoes.
- Dogs and other pets.
- Cameras and autographs are ONLY allowed on-site for the Pro-Am, Monday, October 13, 2008. They are not permitted at Mid Ocean Club during Championship play, Tuesday, October 14 and Wednesday, October 15, 2008.

HELPFUL TIPS

- Remember where your car or motor bike is parked.
- Cameras and autographs are ONLY permitted Monday, October 13, 2008.
- Drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration.
- Wear a hat for protection from the sun and use sun block.
- Wear light colored and cool clothing.
- Stay behind the gallery ropes. All spectators will be able to walk in the fairways behind play. Please cooperate with the marshals.
- Kneel or sit if you are in the front row.
- Remain still throughout each shot.
- Walk carefully, never run.
- Display your ticket conspicuously at all times.
- Bring a rain jacket or poncho.
- Identify a place to meet if you get separated from your companion(s).

MERCHANDISE SHOP

CONCESSION STANDS

Concession stands will be on the golf course in the following locations:

- Main Entrance
- Right of #2 Fairway
- Right of #10 green

In addition, beverage carts and smaller drink stands will be located throughout the golf course.

FIRST AID STATION

The PGA Grand Slam of Golf First Aid Station can be found at the Main Entrance of Mid Ocean Club. If the need for medical assistance should occur, please notify the nearest PGA Grand Slam of Golf Volunteer.

TROPHY PRESENTATION CEREMONY

The Trophy Presentation Ceremony will take place on the 18th green immediately following the close of play on Wednesday, October 15. In the event of a tie for first place after 36 holes, a hole by hole play-off will take place on the following holes in this order: 18 and 17 and repeating Holes 18 and 17 until the tie is broken.

WEATHER INFORMATION

Average Temperatures: Average October temperatures range from a high of 82.3° to a low of 74.3° in the evening. Hats, cool clothing, sunglasses and sunscreen should be worn on bright, sunny days.



Inclement Weather Policy for

All Spectators: Observe the Leaderboards throughout the golf course for the Weather Warning signs that will appear

if The PGA of America becomes aware of inclement weather moving into the area. When the signs appear, you are advised to take precautions and seek shelter PRIOR to play being suspended. If the siren sounds, put down your umbrella, and seek shelter immediately. Please avoid the following:

- Bodies of Water
- Hilltops/High Places
- Open Fields
- Telephone Poles
- Golf Carts
- Tall/Isolated Trees
- Metal Fences
