

HELPFUL TIPS

- Remember where your car is parked.
- Cameras and autographs are ONLY permitted Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20, 2009.
- Drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration. Spectators may bring their own bottled water.
- Wear appropriate clothing for spring in northern Ohio.
- Stay behind the gallery ropes and cooperate with the marshals.
- Kneel or sit if you are in the front row.
- Remain still throughout each shot.
- Walk carefully, never run.
- Display your ticket conspicuously at all times.
- Bring a rain jacket or poncho.
- Identify a place to meet if you get separated from your companion(s).



TROPHY PRESENTATION CEREMONY

The Alfred S. Bourne Trophy Presentation Ceremony will take place on the 18th green immediately following the close of play on Sunday, May 24th. In the event of a tie for first place after 72 holes, a hole-by-hole play-off will take place on the 18th hole. If still tied the following holes will be repeated until the tie is broken: 16, 17, and 18. The Alfred S. Bourne Trophy Presentation Ceremony will then immediately follow the play-off.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR INVITATION

Officers of The PGA of America have approved the following list of players as eligible to compete in the 70th Senior PGA Championship, provided that they are at least 50 years of age:

- Former Senior PGA Champions
- Former PGA Champions
- Former Masters Champions
- Former U.S. Open Champions
- Former British Open Champions
- Former U.S. Ryder Cup Team Members
- The low 15 scorers and ties in the 2008 Senior PGA Championship
- The top 50 money-winners on the 2008 Champions Tour
- The top 50 money-leaders from the 2009 Champions Tour money list as of April 27, 2009
- All "Official" Champions Tour winners from the 2008 Senior PGA Championship up to the 2009 Senior PGA Championship
- The top 35 finishers from the 2008 PGA Senior Club Professional Championship
- Winners of the last five U.S. Senior Opens (2004- 2008)
- The winner of the last played Senior British Open (2008)
- Winner of the 2008 DeVere Collection PGA Seniors' Championship
- Top eighteen players from the 2008 European Senior Tour Order of Merit
- Top two players from the 2009 European Senior Tour Order of Merit not otherwise exempt provided they are in the top 20 of such Order of Merit as of May 11, 2009
- Top four players from the 2008 Japanese Senior Tour Order of Merit
- Winners of Official PGA Tour, JPGA Tour, and European Tour events in the preceding five calendar years (2004-2008) and during the current year up to the Senior PGA Championship – for 50-year-olds only (a one-time exemption)
- Top 30 from the Champions Tour Career Money list as of April 27, 2009
- Top 30 from the All-Time Career Money list as of April 27, 2009
- Any former PGA Professional National Championship champion turning 50 between the 2008 Senior PGA Championship and the 2009 Senior PGA Championship (a one-time exemption)

In addition, The PGA reserves the right to invite additional players not included in the categories listed above.

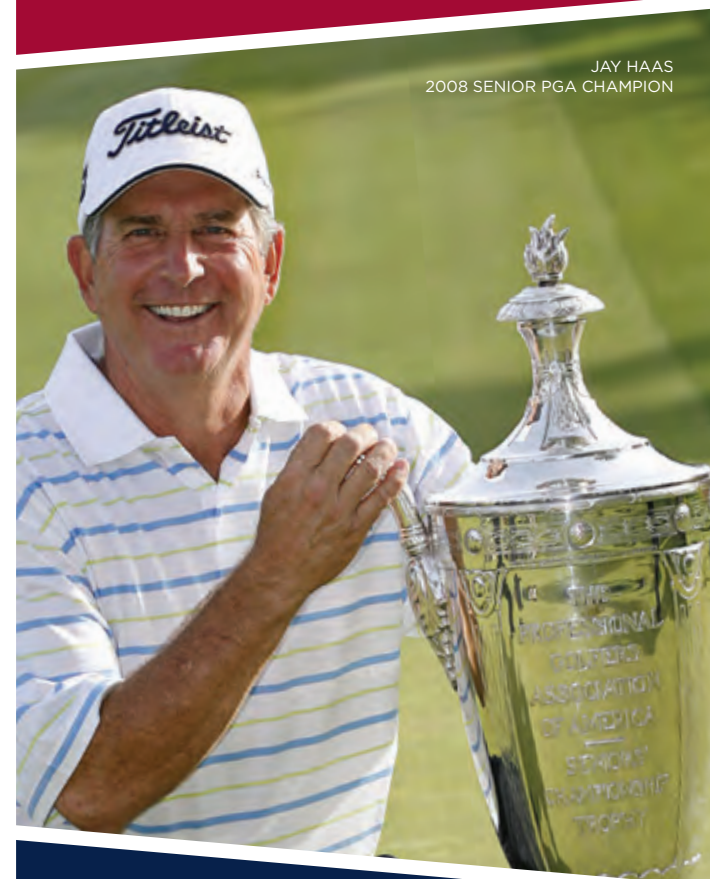

GENERAL INFORMATION

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Autographs may be requested and given at the players' convenience at the Practice Range and Putting Green during the Practice Rounds and Pro-Am, Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 19, 2009. For the players' consideration, a NO AUTOGRAPH POLICY will be enforced on the grounds of Canterbury Golf Club during the Championship Rounds, Thursday, May 21 through Sunday, May 24, 2009.

CAMERA POLICY

Cameras will ONLY be allowed on-site on Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20, 2009. They will not be permitted at Canterbury Golf Club during Championship play, Thursday, May 21 through Sunday, May 24, 2009.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones, pagers, and other electronic devices (see prohibited items) will not be permitted on the grounds at Canterbury Golf Club regardless of profession or current needs. The PGA will provide complimentary phones in multiple locations on the golf course should the need arise for spectators to make a phone call. Please leave cell phones in your vehicle or you may check your phone at the Tech Check location at the Main Entrance or the S. Woodland Road walk up gate each day.

HEALTH SERVICES SHUTTLES

Spectators arriving with pre-existing medical conditions will have an opportunity to utilize a golf cart shuttle to travel to specific locations on the grounds. If you are in need of on course transportation due to a pre-existing medical condition, please seek assistance at either entrance.

JUNIOR ADMISSION POLICY

In an effort to encourage the attendance of our youth, Junior Tickets will be offered to children 17 years of age and younger. Junior Tickets are complimentary and must be acquired by a Senior PGA Championship ticketed adult, who will provide supervision while enjoying the Championship.

Ticketed adults may accompany up to four juniors at any one time. Each adult accompanying a junior must take responsibility for the junior's conduct while enjoying the Championship.

Junior Tickets will be available on a daily basis at Admission Sales located at the Main Entrance.

LOST CHILDREN

All lost children should be taken to the Senior PGA Championship Office, located near #18 Green.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Credit cards and cash are accepted at all concession and beverage stands and in the Canterbury Clubhouse. Travelers checks, credit cards, debit cards and cash are accepted in the Championship Golf Shop.

There will be NO Will Call service for the public at the 70th Senior PGA Championship. Please do not plan to leave tickets for pick-up at Canterbury Golf Club. It is your responsibility to distribute or obtain your tickets prior to arriving on-site.

READMITTANCE POLICY

A ticket, once perforated/scanned, will no longer gain admission to the Championship. If you plan to return to Canterbury Golf Club the same day, please have security stamp your hand at the Main Entrance. You will be able to return to the grounds with a perforated/scanned ticket and a hand stamp.

SITE INFORMATION

ATMS

ATM Services are available at the Golf Shop & Main Entrance of the Senior PGA Championship.

BEVERAGES

Beverage stands will be located at numerous locations throughout the golf course.

CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF SHOP

The Championship Golf Shop is located inside the Canterbury Golf Club Clubhouse. Shop for a wide variety of exclusive 70th Senior PGA Championship branded merchandise.

CONCESSION STANDS

Concession stands will be located:

- Near #18 Green
- Behind #7 Green

FIRST AID STATION

The Senior PGA Championship First Aid Station can be found at the back side of the Clubhouse, closest to the #6 Green.

If the need for medical assistance should occur, please notify the nearest Senior PGA Championship Volunteer. They will be easily identified by their red golf shirts.

GRANDSTANDS

There will be a grandstand located behind the 18th Green. Access to the grandstand is on a first-come, first-serve basis and is free for all spectators.

INFORMATION

Information about the Championship and surrounding community can be found at Spectator Services located at the Main Entrance and the S. Woodland Road Gate.

LOST & FOUND

Lost & Found is located at Spectator Services positioned at the Main Entrance.

THE CANTERBURY CLUBHOUSE

The Canterbury Clubhouse is located by the Practice Green. The facility is reserved for properly credentialed ticket holders who have access to this area. The Championship Golf Shop is also located inside of the Clubhouse and is open to the public.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The items listed are strictly prohibited on the grounds of Canterbury Golf Club at all times. Bags will be searched upon entering the event. Anyone violating these policies will be subject to removal from the grounds and the loss of ticket(s).

- All bags, purses, and backpacks that exceed 12 inches in any dimension (length, height, width, etc.).
- All personal electronics to include radios, televisions (including hand-held), cellular telephones, pagers, palm pilots, hand-held games, walkmans, iPods, etc.
- Bikes, coolers, ladders, milk crates, plastic buckets, signs, banners, lawn chairs (small, folding, canvas chairs are permitted) and metal spiked golf shoes.
- Weapons will not be allowed, REGARDLESS OF PERMIT (including off-duty law enforcement).
- Dogs and other pets.
- Cameras and autographs are ONLY allowed on-site for the Practice Rounds and Pro-Am, Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20, 2009. They are not permitted at Canterbury Golf Club during Championship play, Thursday, May 21 through Sunday, May 24, 2009.

RESTROOMS

Public and handicapped accessible restrooms will be available at the following locations:

- Main Spectator Entrance
- #3 Green
- S. Woodland Spectator Entrance
- Behind Clubhouse

In addition, restroom facilities are located at the Media Center and Canterbury Clubhouse. These facilities are reserved for properly credentialed ticket holders who have access to these areas.

PARKING INFORMATION

GENERAL PUBLIC PARKING

TAXI AND LIMOUSINE DROP-OFF

All taxi and limousine drop-offs will occur at the S. Woodland Road Walk up Gate. Taxi and Limos will be assigned a cell phone lot to stage vehicles. Local police will monitor the drop off for proper usage during Championship week.

STREET PARKING

Street parking is not permitted in the area immediately surrounding Canterbury Golf Club. Spectators may park on streets where prohibitory signage is not present.

Average May temperatures range from a high of 69 degrees to a low of 48 degrees in Cleveland, OH.

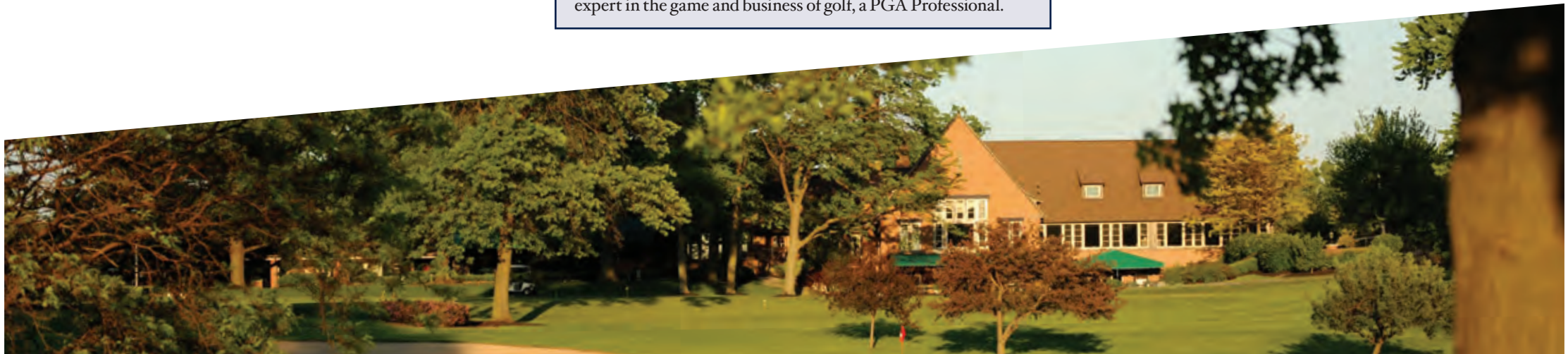
WEATHER WARNING

The PGA of America will be in direct communication with the National Weather Service to receive reports of all threatening weather systems.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR ALL SPECTATORS

Observe the Leaderboards and Thruboards throughout the golf course for the Weather Warning signs that will appear if The PGA becomes aware of inclement weather moving into the area. When the signs appear (symbol above), spectators are advised to take precautions and seek shelter PRIOR to play being suspended. If the siren sounds, put down your umbrella and seek shelter immediately. Please avoid the following:

- Bodies of Water
- Telephone Poles
- Tall/Isolated Trees
- Hilltops/High Places
- Grandstands
- Metal Fence
- Open Fields
- Golf Carts
