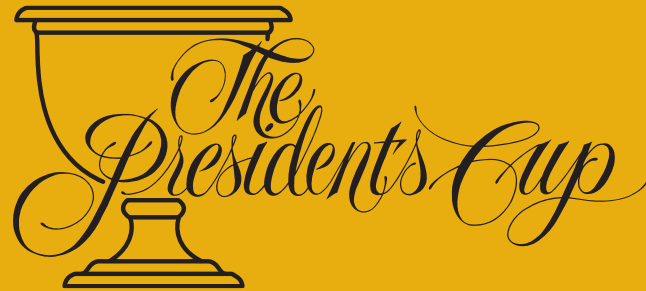


PUBLIC NOTICE



How will The Bayside Area be affected?

This event will attract thousands of spectators to Bayside.

Non-essential traffic should avoid the area.

There will be an increase in vehicle traffic, particularly in Cheltenham. More than 8,000 vehicles are expected to drive to and from the event each day.

Bluff and Reserve Road in particular will experience heavier than usual traffic. Reserve Road, will be used for the Taxi Rank and Public Bus drop-off and pick-up zone.

Cheltenham Road will be closed to through traffic between Tuesday 15th Nov – Sunday 20th Nov.

Bay Road and Park Road will experience higher than usual traffic volumes.

To ensure minimal disruption to Bayside residents and businesses, The Presidents Cup Event Management has prepared a detailed Traffic Management Plan.

Some parking restrictions in streets close to the Royal Melbourne Golf Club will be implemented during the event period, however all affected residents will be provided with Parking Permits.
