Community Warriors

The Warriors, in partnership with Santa Cruz City Schools, launched the fifth annual “Read to Achieve” season, presented by Kaiser Permanente, on Monday! During the 2015-16 campaign, seven elementary and middle schools throughout the area read more than 513 million words, besting previous years’ totals by more than 200 million words. This year’s program will reach over 7,000 students in Santa Cruz and Monterey counties over the next three months through the addition of expansion schools and events throughout the Central Coast.

The Sea Dubs will once again team up with local nonprofit the Coastal Watershed Council to host our second annual river cleanup near Kaiser Permanente Arena on Wednesday, February 1! Players, coaches, front office team members, and other volunteers will work to clean up the Santa Cruz Riverwalk along the San Lorenzo River to reconnect a healthy river to our vibrant community.

RECENT GAMES RECAP

Jan. 19 – The Warriors fell to the Oklahoma City Blue 95-86 in their first matchup of the 2017 NBA D-League Showcase. Scott Wood and Alex Hamilton paced the Dubs with 16 points apiece, while Dennis Clifford notched a double-double with 14 points and 15 boards. LaDontae Henton added 13 points and 6 rebounds.

Jan. 21 – Santa Cruz defeated the Texas Legends 113-97 in their second and final game of the 2017 NBA D-League Showcase. Seven Warriors finished the game in double-digit scoring, including Dennis Clifford’s double-double performance of 17 points and 10 rebounds. Scott Wood contributed 17 points, including 5 3-pointers.

Jan. 27 – The Dubs defeated the Salt Lake City Stars 123-97, breaking an all-time franchise record by shooting 61% from beyond-the-arc to go with six Warriors scoring in double-figures. LaDontae Henton led all scorers with 22 points, 4 assists and 4 rebounds, going 6-of-10 from three-pointers. James Southerland recorded a double-double with 14 points and 10 assists.

Jan. 28 – The Warriors defeated the Rio Grande Valley Vipers 123-115. Scott Wood led all scorers with 32 points while shooting 10-of-20 from beyond-the-arc to set an all-time franchise record for made three-pointers in a game! Alex Hamilton added 20 points and 6 assists off the bench, while Phil Pressey notched a triple-double with 15 points, 14 rebounds, and 13 assists.
